I. AB 212 Program Update

- Coordinator submitted the final yearend report to the Department of Education, Early Education Services Division. It was reported that 100 child care center staff attended professional development trainings. Almost \$10,000 was distributed to teaching staff that attended the trainings.

II. QRIS Infant/Toddler & Preschool

- Coordinator collaborated with QRIS partners to provide the CA Teaching Pyramid Make and Take Back to School training on Friday, August 25th.

III. Childhood Advisory Council – Central Coast Conference

- Coordinator and subcommittee members continue to plan for the Central Coast Conference, on Saturday, October 7th in Aptos. The conference theme is *Mindful Leaders: Transforming the Lives of Children*. The conference will include keynote, two workshop sessions, mid-morning snack and exhibits.

IV. California Transitional Kindergarten Stipend Program (CTKS)

- Coordinator continues to outreach and recruit new transitional kindergarten teachers to share program reimbursement information and professional development opportunities.
